The energy of the future: what are our alternatives?

The world's growing population and the demand for energy pose a major challenge. People are looking for new ways to generate electricity and heat. They are also looking for ways to use energy more efficiently and to reduce the amount of waste they produce.

The power industry has been the subject of a lot of discussion. Some people think that the best way to generate electricity is by using fossil fuels. Others think that renewable energy sources are the best way to generate electricity.

There are several advantages to using renewable energy sources. First, they are clean and do not produce any pollution. Second, they are sustainable and will never run out. Third, they are often cheaper than fossil fuels in the long run.

However, there are also some disadvantages to using renewable energy sources. For example, they can be unreliable and their output can vary depending on the weather. Also, they often require a lot of land and water to produce.

Despite these challenges, many people believe that renewable energy sources are the best way to generate electricity in the future. They think that we need to start using them now to make sure we have enough energy for the future.

What is geothermal energy?

However, there are also some challenges to using geothermal energy. It is a relatively expensive technology and it can be difficult to find suitable locations for geothermal power plants. Also, there is a risk of seismic activity associated with geothermal energy production.

Despite these challenges, many people believe that geothermal energy is a promising source of renewable energy for the future. They think that it has the potential to provide a clean and sustainable source of energy that can help to reduce our dependence on fossil fuels.

Paper 1 Reading and Use of English Test 1

Bob Dylan – The Artist

A Bob Dylan is an internationally renowned singer, songwriter and author. He is held in such high esteem that he won the Nobel Prize in Literature in October 2016 for having created new poetic expressions within the great American song tradition. He is also a prolific artist and painter. He started by doing drawings for his album covers in the 1960s and in 1974 spent two intensive months studying painting. A book of 92 drawings called *Drawn Blank* was published in 1994. One of his major exhibitions called *Bob Dylan on Canvas* was at the Halycon Gallery in central London. The show opened in October 2008 and it was the first time that Dylan displayed works he had painted using acrylics. The paintings quickly sold out and this inspired him into a burst of creativity using this medium.

B He completed 50 paintings which became known as the *Brazil Series*. These were exhibited at the Statens Museum for Kunst in Copenhagen, Denmark which opened in 2010. Visitors saw how the artist had made preliminary drawings while he was in Brazil with his band. He developed these into richly coloured pictures of what he had seen while he was travelling. These included landscapes of the countryside and cityscapes particularly showing the poorer areas known as favelas. There were also paintings of interesting characters such as musicians, card players and even criminals. The next major landmark in his career was his first show in New York in autumn 2011. The *Asia Series* depicted the time he spent in China, Japan, Vietnam and Korea. The following year he was awarded the United States Presidential Medal of Freedom by Barack Obama.

C His extraordinary creative energy did not diminish and in February 2012, an exhibition of 23 paintings completed in New Orleans went on display at the Palazzo Reale, Milan. Later in the year, in a change of direction he exhibited work, again at the Halycon Gallery, of gales created from iron and bronze. His work in *Mondo Scripto* features some of his most iconic lyrics which are handwritten by him on pen and paper and accompanied by an original pencil drawing. In this way he has fused together a number of his artistic disciplines. He has changed some of the words in his songs and even completely rewritten one, especially for the exhibition, in order to bring a new perspective to his writing.

D Although Dylan is now in his late seventies, he continues to write, paint, draw and give concerts. His singing voice is not as good as it was when he first played in Greenwich Village as a folk singer. At a recent concert he was even booed when he left the stage. However, his artwork continues to inspire people from different generations. A recent display of his work in Shanghai, China called *RetroSpectrum* aims to tell the story of his art rather than focusing on individual pieces. It is difficult to predict what he will come up with for future projects. Throughout his long career his desire to experiment has produced many surprises.

Little Women Success over the Years

Little Women was an immediate success when it was first written in 1868. Since then, the story has been used in many forms of entertainment. Let's have a look at some of them.



Little Women at the Opera

There is also an opera of *Little Women*, composed in 1998 by Mark Adamo. It was a huge success. Since then, it has been performed not only in the United States, but in countries all over the world, such as Mexico, Japan, Australia, Canada and Belgium.

Little Women at the Cinema

The first two films made about *Little Women* in 1917 and 1918 were silent versions. Then, in 1933, the first 'talking' version was made, starring the famous American actress Katharine Hepburn. She played the part of Jo in the film. The film cost \$1 million and took a year to make, with 4,000 people working on it. Like the book, the film was an immediate success and earned more than \$100,000 in the first week.

Another film was made in 1949, and the most recent, with Winona Ryder and Susan Sarandon, came out in 1994. In this film, Susan Sarandon was Marmee, while Winona Ryder played the part of Jo, and received an *Academy Award Nomination* as Best Actress.



Little Women: The Musical

Jason Howland wrote the music for this musical based on Louisa Alcott's stories about the March family.

It opened on Broadway at the Virginia Theatre on 23rd January, 2005 and was repeated 137 times. It then went on tour and covered 30 cities in the United States. The musical was also performed in Sydney, Australia for a month in 2008.

Little Women on TV

In 1950 and 1958, the BBC showed a six-part series based on *Little Women*. Then, in 1981, a Japanese company, Toei Animation, made an animated television series of *Little Women*. This was followed by another animated version in 1987 by another Japanese company, Nippon Animation. Both series were shown in English on American television.

- **Theatre video tutorial**

The video contains the complete staging of the musical. It provides instructions for the pupils on how to recite by demonstrating the movements and gestures of the characters and illustrates the organisation of the space on stage, which could be a classroom, a gym, a garden or a courtyard.

- **Props and costume video tutorial**

The costumes and props are made with recycled materials, unexpensive and easy to find. A workshop-guide stimulates the children's imagination and creativity.

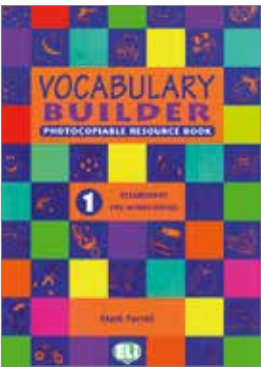

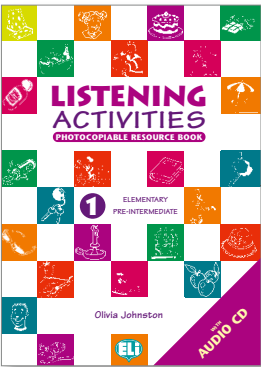
